Betreft: schoolopening 8 februari

Dear parents and / or guardians,

As I am sure you will have heard, the Dutch primary schools are reopening on Monday 8th February. We are delighted that the children can return to school. However, there are various conditions in place, which you need to be fully aware of.

Your school is working hard to ensure a safe learning environment for all the children. We are very aware of the 'British strain' of the virus, which is particularly contagious for adults.

This in itself poses a risk for our teaching staff. Here at Innoord, it is fundamental that we adhere to the guidelines, established by the RIVM:

- If your child has Corona-related symptoms, they must stay at home and / or have a corona test. If their teacher raises concerns regarding possible symptoms, you must keep your child at home, or arrange a Corona test.
- We also request that you keep your child at home if he or she has a mild cold. The risk of a cold being a part of the British strain is currently being investigated by the RIVM. Until we have confirmation of this evidence, this measure will remain.
- If anyone tests positive for Corona, the school will be informed by the GGD. If your child tests positive, we would highly appreciate it if you could inform the school yourself.
- If someone in your child's class has tested positive for Corona, (pupil or teacher), the entire class must quarantine (at home) for 5 days. If possible, the school will organize online lessons. You will be informed about this by

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the school's director. Your child can only return to school after 5 days, with a negative corona test result. If you do not want your child to be tested, the quarantine period will be extended for another 5 days. After this 10 day period, they may return to school.

- Pupils in groups 7 & 8 can use a mouth mask. Please bring your own from home. Facemasks will also be available at school.
- The Dutch government strongly advises employees who work with students in groups 7 & 8 to wear a mouth mask. This is not mandatory, purely discretionary.
- Children in the older classes should, where possible, come to school alone. If parents feel the need to bring / collect their child, please arrange that this is done by one parent. The school will assign a designated pick up place.
- We ask you wear a mouth mask when bringing and collecting your child.
- Children must attend school, unless there are medical reasons. In case of any sickness please consult the school and the education board, who will determine whether an exemption may be granted.


Ensuring a precedent is set to regulate and provide a feasible and safe education. The Director and school council will collaborate to ensure a smooth opening and forthcoming term, up until and including the spring break. Your school Director will be in touch directly.

Childcare will also reopen. As you know, we work closely with our connected organizations. Unfortunately, the BSO will remain closed (with the exception of key workers). Your child care organizations will be in direct contact. If you are a key worker and require additional childcare, please contact the school.

I can imagine that you may have questions regarding the above information. Therefore, the GGD has organised a webinar to address any issues. Your director will be in touch with all the details in due course.

We are delighted that the schools are reopening, but it's essential that we work together to ensure they remain this way. Therefore, I ask that you adhere to the measures in place to help us provide continuous, quality education.
